SOULS SAVING MINISTRY

This ministry was revived last January with the goal of preaching the gospel in towns and villages around Douala. It is a team of 9 seasoned preachers (Two are missing in the picture above). They go out every 3 months and have made two outings thus far (Bomono and Bonaberi) 4 days of evangelism rewarded by two baptisms and plenty of seeds sown. This mission has been placed under the responsibility of Asikpo Denis (5th guy counting from Louis)

THE RADIO MINISTRY

The weekly radio program is every Sunday from 5:30 pm to 7pm. Camwork has assigned the management of this program to Missango Franklin whose input is a great blessing. The listeners day took place on the 8th of December 2024. Out of 17 listeners who regularly called, 4 came to the radio for a moment of face to face interaction. Finger-food was provided. Camwork T -shirts, giftbags and WBS Bible (Courtesy of Norman and Louise Clement) were given to each listener. One of the listeners (Christian Bappa and his family) who has been worshipping with one of the congregations of the churches of Christ in Douala, recently started a cell meeting that Camwork is very willing to supervise. THE MOUNGO ZONAL EVANGELISM

The evangelistic and edification gathering took place in Bomono in January. This edition was unique for two reasons: Camwork brought in the Soul Saving Ministry team for an intense door to door evangelism and introducing the church in its new neighborhood. Camwork also brought in a team of health personnels for a health talk (drowning, snake bites, etc.) and the checking of blood pressures and blood sugar level.
